

# Numbers have gone up

The Government missed its target to reduce the number of people with a learning disability and/or autism stuck in inpatient units by 35-50% by the end of March 2019.

This is the **second monthly increase** in the number of people locked away since the targets were missed.

# Where is the cross-government strategy?

There is still **no robust plan** with leadership across government to ensure health, social care, education and **housing** work together to get people out of inpatient units and back into their community.
