At risk

Over 10,000

April to June 2019

reported uses of restrictive interventions in three months e.g. **physical, chemical, mechanical restraint** and being **kept in isolation**.

Of these, almost a third

3,230

were against **Children** (under 18s)

The number of children with a learning disability and/or autism in inpatient units has **increased**.

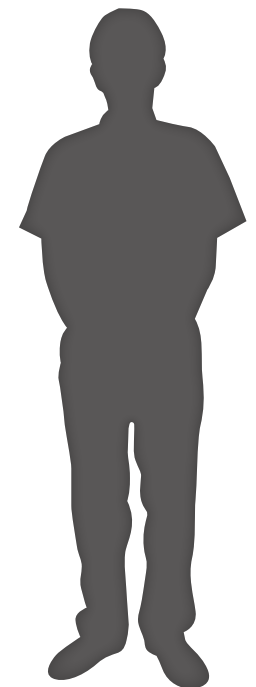
