Shocking levels of restrictive practices

3,615

Within July 2022

The number of children with a learning disability and/or autism in inpatient units has **increased** since the start of the Transforming Care programme.

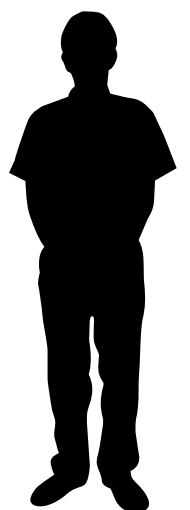
